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**Introduction to Swans**

Thank you for your enquiry about being a Swan's helper with the Swans Swimming Club.

All Swan's helpers must undergo an Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) disclosure. All Carers/Personal Assistants who accompany swimmers in the water must have an Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) disclosure.

With this 'Introduction to Swans' you will receive a further 3 pieces of information (a total of 4 pieces).

3. General Information
4. Helpers DBS verification form **(to be completed)**

**What you need to do:**

Please complete forms 2 and 4. On your first visit, bring your completed forms and give them to the Swans Instructor who is 'in-charge' at the pool side. This normally would be Ann Gresswell on Tuesday evenings at Leys Pool or Hazel Beaver on Saturday mornings at Ferry Pool.

On your first visit you will be given 6 further documents that you will also need to read. You will need to complete 6 and 7.
